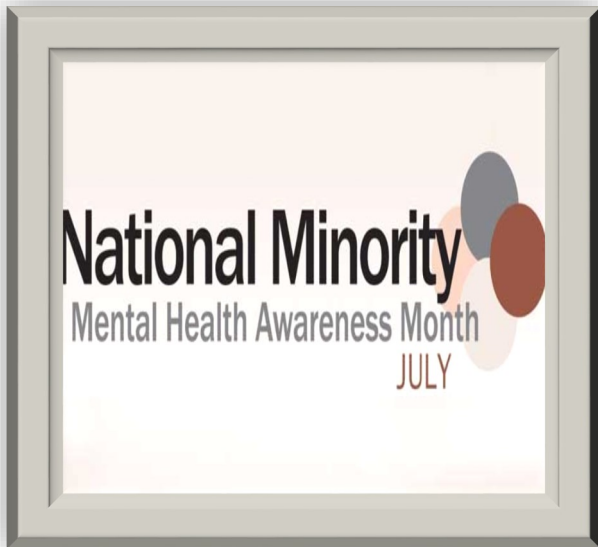




“From the RHBC Health Ministry”

Health Awareness Month



Despite advances in health equity, disparities in mental health care persist. Reports indicate that racial & ethnic minority groups in the US are less likely to have access to community mental health services; are more likely to use the emergency rooms & more likely to receive lower quality care; which contributes to poor mental outcomes, including suicides; which is now the 2nd leading cause of death in the 15-24 yr old African Americans. Suicides are noted to occur in Black men more than 4 times greater than that of Black women. For the month of July, We must provide more public mental health education & awareness; the accessible resources; encourage the use of stress management tools & help break down the barrier of the negative perception of mental illness
