August is Skin Cancer Awareness Month



“Although we are still in a “stay at home” mode due to the Pandemic, we must as much as possible, spend time outdoors for our source of Vitamin D. People of all colors, including those of brown & black skin, get skin cancer. Even if you think you never get a sun burn, you can get skin cancer. When it develops in people of color, it’s often in a late stage when diagnosed, & spread quickly. The good news is you can find it early & most can be cured. So to reduce your risk; check your skin regularly for changes in the sizes or shapes in moles, warts, freckles, blemishes, etc; wear protective clothing when outdoors & use sunscreen SPF30 or greater. Remember to Stay safe & healthy as you maintain the 3Ws: Wash, Wait & Wear your mask when unable to social distance when outside.”
